









Pfizer Patient Access Coordinators help you access your Pfizer Dermatology prescription

A **Patient Access Coordinator (PAC)** is a Pfizer professional who can explain how your insurance works and how you can obtain your Pfizer Dermatology prescription from the Specialty Pharmacy.

If you are enrolled in Pfizer Dermatology Patient Access™ (PDPA), you will automatically be opted in to PAC support.












If you are prescribed CIBINQO, your assigned PAC will be the SPOC (single point of contact) for you, and the PAC can:

-  **Serve** as a subject matter expert on reimbursement, access, and coverage issues
-  **Provide** an estimated out-of-pocket cost for your prescription, if it applies
-  **Educate** you about resources and connect you to Pfizer Dermatology Patient Access™ (PDPA), the patient support services program
-  **Explain** your summary of benefits, and whether prior authorization is required
-  **Offer** you live access and reimbursement support, and share appropriate touchpoints and status updates over the phone
-  **Connect** you to PDPA-specific resources and affordability options for which you may be eligible
-  **Assist** with copay enrollment and activation support
-  **Address** patient inquiries and provide status updates regarding the prescription process



If you are prescribed LITFULO, your assigned PAC will be the SPOC (single point of contact) for both you and your prescriber, and the PAC can:

-  **Serve** as a subject matter expert on reimbursement, access, and coverage issues
-  **Explain** your summary of benefits, and whether prior authorization is required
-  **Educate** you about resources and connect you to Pfizer Dermatology Patient Access™ (PDPA), the patient support services program
-  **Provide** an estimated out-of-pocket cost for your prescription, if it applies
-  **Offer** you live access and reimbursement support, and share appropriate touchpoints and status updates over the phone
-  **Address** inquiries from healthcare providers about prescription status **AND** patient questions about prescription status in Pfizer patient access and support programs
-  **Connect** you to PDPA-specific resources and affordability options for which you may be eligible
-  **Coordinate** with HCPs and Pfizer patient access and support programs to understand payer requirements regarding individual patient cases that are enrolled in the patient support program
-  **Assist** with copay enrollment and activation support
